1 Summary and background

IT Partners Telco Sp. z o.o. here in after called “Buyer” is currently accepting proposals for the provision of experimental and development services related to the configuration, adaptation and integration of LTE Mission Critical X (MCX) components. LTE Mission Critical X (MCX) components together with the LTE base station hardware platform designed by the IT Partners Telco, will constitute a new product of the Network in a Box type for critical applications. This request is a part of the „Innovative LTE-Advanced 450MHz microcell for critical communication systems” R&D project carried out under the „Path for Mazovia” program led by The National Centre for Research and Development in Poland.

IT Partners Telco Sp. z o.o. was founded in 2005 and is focused on developing and integrating wireless telecommunication systems for private operators. Starting from 2017 the company is also developing small cell products for private networks. IT Partners Telco Sp. z o.o. is located in Warsaw, Poland, and serves customers in Central Eastern Europe directly or globally thru partners.

The purpose of this Request For Proposal (RFP) is to solicit proposals from candidate companies, conduct a fair and extensive evaluation based on criteria listed herein, and select the candidate who best addresses the needs of IT Partners Telco Sp. z o.o. in the context of experimental and development services related to the configuration, adaptation and integration of LTE Mission Critical X (MCX) components. All proposals should be placed till 05.01.2022 according to Proposal Guidelines.

2 Proposal Guidelines

1. The offer should be submitted on a template Price Offer Form – Attachment no. 1 to this inquiry.
2. The offer should be signed by a person authorized to represent the Bidder.
3. The offer should be submitted in a paper form at the Project Office (Str Tarnogórska 12, 03-679 Warsaw) or in electronic form (as a file in PDF format) sent to the address zamowienia@itpartners.com.pl not later than on 05.01.2022.
4. Offers submitted after the deadline will not be considered.
5. The Buyer reserves the right to check the Bidder’s human resources potential whose offer received the highest rating, through an interview and test tasks.

3 Scope of the Work

The subject of this request is the **experimental and development services related to the configuration, adaptation and integration of LTE Mission Critical X (MCX) components. LTE Mission Critical X (MCX) components together with the LTE base station hardware platform designed by the IT Partners Telco, will constitute a new product of the Network in a Box type for critical applications.** Because of the developmental nature of the work, the exact scope of tasks will be each time specified within partial orders corresponding to the current support needs of the Ordering Party. Examples of tasks will include: implementation of the MCX application server and its integration with the EPC core, implementation of a VoIP PBX switchboard, implementation of a disassembly dispatch console, integration with the 3GPP IMS multimedia subsystem

4 Timelines

The end date for the provision of experimental and development services is 02/28/2022.

5 Bidder Qualifications

The Bidder should have at least one developer of telecommunications systems software with min. 5 years of experience, documented experience in working on a project whose subject was the configuration, adaptation and integration of LTE Mission Critical components.

6 Submission of the offer

The Bidder is obligated to submit Attachment no. 1 (Offer Form) to this inquiry and the following, required documents:

1. Statement of the fulfillment of the conditions for the participation in the procedure and of no grounds for exclusion from the procedure (included in The Offer Form, attached as Attachment no. 1),
2. Statement of no relation to The Buyer (included in The Offer Form, attached as Attachment no. 1),
3. Description of the Bidder's experience confirming its skills necessary to the provision of the configuration, adaptation and integration of LTE Mission Critical components (attached as Attachment no. 3),
4. Description of the Bidder's human resources potential confirming its possibilities to the provision of the configuration, adaptation and integration of LTE Mission Critical components (attached as Attachment no. 2).

7 Proposal Evaluation Criteria

In case of submission of more than one offer, the Buyer will select the most advantageous offer based on the following criteria. The maximum number of points that an offer can receive is 100 points (in total). The tender that scores the highest number of points based on the below-mentioned criteria will be considered the most favorable.

- PC – price criterion, net price in EUR. Weight of the criterion: 80%. Maximum score: 80 points.
Description of the method of awarding points for meeting this offer evaluation criterion:

$$\text{PC} = \text{Minimal price} / \text{Offer price} \times 80 \text{ points}$$

PC – number of the points awarded for the examined offer,

The minimal price is understood as the lowest price among the submissions, examined offers.

Offer price – the price of the examined offer.

The highest number of points for this criterion would be awarded for the offer of the lowest price.

- DG - guarantee duration criterion. Weight 20%. Maximum number of points: 20 points.
Description of the method of awarding points for meeting a given offer evaluation criterion:

$$\text{DG} = \text{Extending the guarantee / warranty period for the services provided up to 24 months in the offer presented} - 20 \text{ points.}$$

The maximum number of points that an offer can receive for this part equals 100 points.

8 Exclusion

In order to avoid a conflict of interest, entities related to The Buyer may not apply for the contract. Therefore, applicants can not be an entity:

- Related or being a subsidiary, jointly dependent, or dominant entity in relation to the Bidder in accordance with the Act of accounting of September 29, 1994.
- Remaining with The Bidder or with the members of its organs in such a factual or legal relationship that may raise justified doubts to the impartiality in the choice of the Contractor – marriage, kinship or affinity up to the second degree, adoption, guardianship, also through membership in the organs of the Contractor,
- Related or in partnership relation to the Bidder in accordance with Regulation No. 651/2014,
- Personally related to the Bidder according to the Art. 32 sec.2 in accordance with Act of tax on goods and services of March 11, 2004.

In order to confirm the lack of the premise for exclusion from the procedure, The Contractor is obliged to submit the statement contained in Attachment no. 1 - The Offer Form.

9 Privacy Policy
